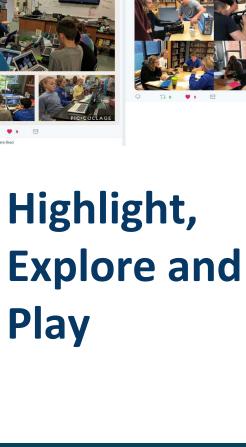
- 17-18: Develop FTIS Portrait of a Graduate

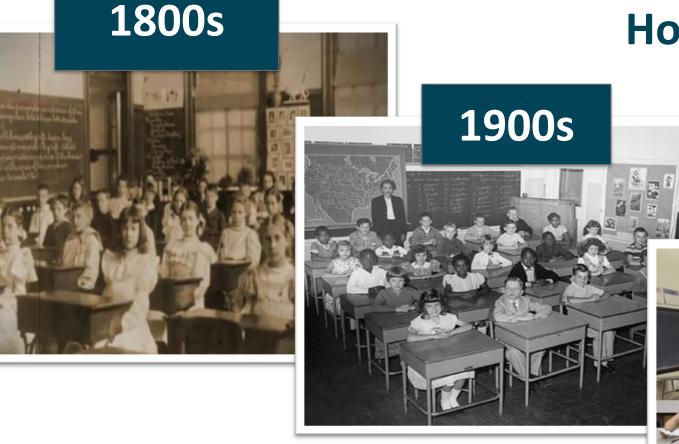
The Nested System



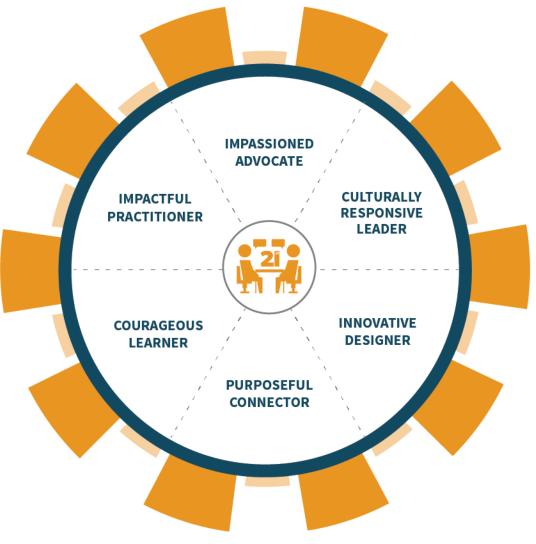

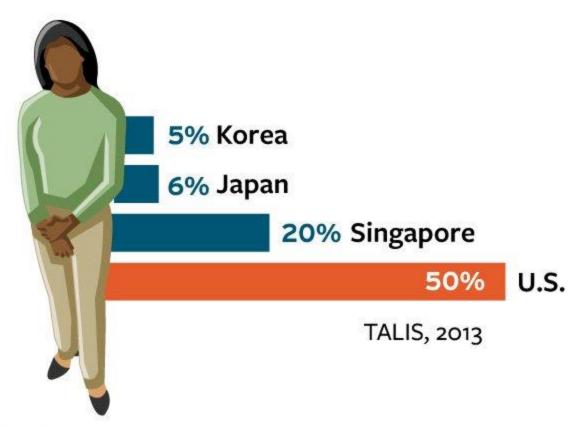
